

IRP LEO and EMS SOP

Production Standards for Police and Ambulance Roleplay

Serious RP • No RDM • No VDM • Rules Enforced

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Golden Rule: Finish the scene IC. If something is wrong, report after via Discord tickets with evidence.

0. Purpose

This SOP defines production expectations for law enforcement (LEO) and emergency medical services (EMS). These roles set the tone of professionalism server-wide.

1. Definitions and Quality Standards

IRP is a serious roleplay environment. The standards below apply to all players unless a role-specific section overrides them.

Key Terms

- IC (In Character): Everything your character says/does in the city.
- OOC (Out of Character): Real-life talk. Keep it out of active scenes.
- Scene: Any continuous interaction (stop, robbery, chase, negotiation, investigation, medical).
- RDM: Attacking without roleplay lead-up.
- VDM: Using vehicles as weapons without roleplay justification.
- Powergaming: Forcing outcomes or using unrealistic actions to gain advantage.
- Metagaming: Using OOC information IC (Discord, streams, map pings, player names).
- FailRP: Ignoring realism or consequences.
- NVL: Not valuing life in a believable threat scenario.

IRP Quality Bar

- Roleplay first: immersion and story beat speed-running mechanics.
- Clarity: communicate in-character and keep scenes readable.
- Consequences are content: losses and setbacks are story progression.
- Respect: you can play a rude character without being rude OOC.

Golden Rule: Do not argue OOC inside an active scene. Finish the scene IC, then report concerns through Discord tickets with evidence.

2. Shared Standards (LEO + EMS)

- Professionalism always: calm tone and respectful language.
- Scene first: do not rush outcomes; let RP breathe.
- No OOC policing mid-scene. Report issues after with evidence.
- Avoid ego. Authority roleplay should create scenes, not end them.

3. LEO SOP (Police)

Traffic Stops and Contacts

- Clear communication: reason for stop, instructions, next steps.
- Proportional escalation. Do not jump to cuffs or weapons without justification.
- Allow suspects to roleplay nervousness, confusion, or negotiation.

Use of Force (Principles)

- Force must be proportional and justified by threat, not frustration.
- Avoid punishment mindset. Your goal is fair RP and consequences.

Investigations

- Use witnesses, evidence, vehicle descriptions, and follow-ups.
- Build cases over time. Not every crime is solved instantly.

Integrity: Do not use OOC knowledge. Discordstreams are not evidence.

4. EMS SOP (Ambulance)

Medical Neutrality

- Remain neutral and patient-focused. Do not take sides in conflicts.

Treatment RP Standards

- Communicate assessment, triage, treatment, transport.
- Encourage injury roleplay rather than instant resets.

Scene Safety

- Do not enter active firefights. Stage until cleared or scene is safe.

- Coordinate with LEO for access and perimeter.
